Deadline for entries: Friday 28th November 2025 (**Note:** late entries will be considered, subject to availability)

Registration: Registration will open at 09:00am. Archery GB membership cards must be produced on the day. Anyone unable to produce their membership **card or e-card** will not be permitted to shoot. **We cannot gain access to the sports hall at all until 8.30am, so please give our club members time to set up before arriving from 9am.**

Dress Code: Archery GB rules of shooting and dress code (rule 307) apply.

Shooting: We will be shooting according to AGB rules of shooting; 3 arrows in 2 minutes at each end, with 2 ends of sighters. Compounds will shoot on individual 3-spot vertical faces. Other bow types on single spot faces, unless requested otherwise. Single spots will share, with 2 archers per face. We will have 4 foam targets and 4 straw. Compounds will be prioritised to shoot on foam, all other bow styles may shoot on straw. We will only accept single entries.

U18 Competitors: Anyone under the age of 18 is to be accompanied by a parent or guardian for the duration of the tournament.

Results and Awards: Awards and results will be presented at the end of the afternoon shoot according to entries.

Data Protection: Please note that by entering this competition, you agree to allow Tockington Archers to use your details for administrative purposes only. Information such as email address, mailing address and phone number(s) will not be published or shared. The target and results list will be sent to all competitors via email, when a valid one has been provided. Ianseo will be used to run this tournament and your details will thus be entered onto the online portal. Results will also be published on the Tockington Archers website. Junior's date of birth will only be used for checking the correct age category for entry and will not be published.

Photography: Anyone wishing to take photographs or video during the tournament must register their details with the Tournament Organiser upon arrival. If any parents/carers have any concerns about their child being photographed or filmed, they should speak with the Tournament Organiser.


Refreshments: Hot and cold drinks along with a selection of sweet treats will be available. Cash and card via Sum Up accepted.

Tombola: A fantastic tombola will run throughout the day, so please try your luck and have a go! Cash and card via Sum Up accepted.


Notes:
